ANSWERS:

1. Answer in one or two words:

(a) Where should we keep our belongings at home?

Ans: In the cupboard or other storage areas.

(b) What could happen if we play with electric plugs or gadgets?

Ans: Doing so might result in an electrical shock.

(c) Why should we not play near the road?

Ans: Never play near or on the road as you may get hit by a moving vehicle.

(d) When should we open the front door?

Ans: If you know the person who has come.

2. Answer in brief:

(a) What should be done in case suspect a fire in the house?

Ans: Alert any grown-up in the house in case you suspect a fire in the house.

(b) How should we cross a road?

Ans: Always use the zebra crossing to cross the road. Never cross the road in a rush. Look to your right, then left, then right again. Ensure that the road is clear of traffic before crossing it.

(c) List any two safety rules to be followed in school.

Ans: We must follow certain safety rules a school too.

- 1. Do not hit other students or throw things around. Someone can get hurt.
- 2. Do not run or slide down a staircase. If you lose balance, you could have a bad fall.
